



Below is a list of common medications used to treat diabetes, prediabetes, overweight, and obesity.

Many health insurance plans do not cover weight loss medications; and brand name only drugs may be expensive.

-Some insurance plans only cover certain medications if you have particular diagnoses (overweight, obesity, morbid obesity.) (Some examples of codes =E66.9, E11.9)

-Many insurance plans will cover diabetic medication (for example: Ozempic) if you have diabetes, but will not cover if you “only” have prediabetes.

-Some insurance plans only cover certain medications if you have tried and failed other medications first.

-Some insurance plans only cover certain medications if you have comorbid conditions (hypertension, hyperlipidemia, sleep apnea, etc)

-Some insurance plans do not provide all of the necessary information over the phone, or sometimes provide inaccurate information when you call.

-If you need a prior authorization; please allow up to 2-3 weeks for your insurance company to process it.
